Subject :- Types of Interrogative Sentence

We will talk about the first type of interrogative sentence that is whquestion.

1-Wh-question: This types can be formed through the relation between whquestion and an object in a declarative sentence.

We have many types of wh-question and we will explain them in details :

- 9-How long: This article refers to a length or duration(like ten meters long , for one week , for one month) . for example :
 - -They lived in Bahrain for four years .

To change a declarative sentence into interrogative, we will apply the following steps:

- 1-The above sentence is declarative.
- 2-It consists of a subjective pronoun (They), a main verb (lived), a direct object ,prepositional phrases (in) a preposition (Bahrain) a noun, an indirect object prepositional phrases (for) a preposition (four) cardinal number (years), a plural noun.
- 3- We put a wh —question (How long) at the beginning of sentence because an indirect object refers to a duration (for four years).
- 4-We omit an object (for four years).
- 5-The tense of sentence is the simple past tense, and it does not contain an auxiliary verb.

- 6-We must derivate an auxiliary verb according to tense of the sentence that is (did).
- 7-We put a subjective pronoun (they).
- 8- We change a main verb (live) from past into present because of existence (did)
- 9-We put a preposition phrases (in Bahrain).
- 10-We add a question mark (?) at the end of sentence.
- 11- An interrogative sentence is:

How long did the live in Bahrain?

Another example:

This classroom is six meters long.

following steps:

- 1-The above sentence is declarative.
- 2-It consists of a noun phrase , (This) a demonstrative pronoun (classroom) a noun , a an axillary verb (is), an object ,a cardinal number (six) , a tool of length (meters), (long) a noun .
- 3- We put a wh –question (How long) at the beginning of sentence because an object refers to a length (six meters long).
- 4-We omit an object (six meters long).
- 5-We put an auxiliary verb (is).
- 6-We put a subject (this classroom).
- 7-We add a question mark (?) at the end of sentence.
- 8- An interrogative sentence is:

How long is this classroom?
