Subject :- Passive voice

Passive voice :- We will talk about two subjects related with passive voice : its definitions, and uses.

As a passive voice relates with sentence , we must mention a brief introduction about sentence and then explains a passive voice .

- Sentence is a group of words that are put together to mean something . A complete sentence has at least a subject and a main verb to state (declare) a complete thought .

- For example , She walks .

- Sentence is a largest unit of language . In English , it begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop, or a question mark , or an exclamation mark

For example :-

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- Ali writes a letter .

A sentence consists of subject , verb , and object .

- A subject is a part of sentence that contains the person or thing performing the action (or verb ) in a sentence .

- Verb is word that show an action (sing ), occurrence (develop ) , or a state of being (exist ).

- Object is a noun , a noun phrase or a pronoun that is affected by the action of a verb or a preposition . Direct object (e.g. I know him) . Indirect object (e. g Give her the prize) .

-Active voice means that a sentence has a subject that acts upon its verb .

For example :-

He writes a letter.

- Passive voice means that a subject is a recipient of a verb's action

- Passive voice is used to emphasis an action (verb) and the object of a sentence rather than who or what a responsible for it(subject).

For example :-

A letter is written by him .

B:- We use a passive voice in the following states :-

1-When the action interests us more than the agent .

2- When we don't know the agent .

3-When it is easy to figure out who the agent is .
